Re:Store: Heritage Sign and Mural Trail

The Re:Store: Heritage Sign and Mural Trail is a Shire wide project that celebrates community, heritage and history. The project will involve the restoration of old and damaged advertising signage across the Shire. This project will also include the production of maps and information brochures, and a webpage to help promote the project to a broader audience.



The first restoration was completed recently, a large scale restoration on the side of a prominent shop front next door to the Coolamon School of Arts building.

With funding through NSW Government's Stronger Country Communities

Fund, the project will be rolled out through all six towns and villages throughout our Shire. The restorations will be completed by local signwritter Ricky Hard of Regal Signs over the next 2 years.
