School Based Traineeship 2022-2023 Apply Now!



Council Roads Update

Road Conditions

Recent good rain has been welcomed with the majority of dams replenished. This has permitted Council to commence gravel road maintenance and gravel resheets. Council's three grader crews are spread across the Shire Road Network and addressing priority items first. Rural water access is appreciated if available.

Road Closures

All Shire roads are open at present.

Companion Animals

From 1 July 2021 owners of cats not desexed by four months of age will be required to pay an \$81 annual permit in addition to their one-off lifetime pet registration fee.

All dogs in NSW must be microchipped by the age of 12 weeks and registered by the age of 6 months, Cats by 4 Failure to do so will incur a fine of \$330.00 per dog/cat. Registration will still be required to be paid as well as the infringement notice.

The fine for owners of dogs that are found wandering from their place of residence is also \$330.00.

If an animal is found roaming the streets and cannot be identified and returned to their owners within the allotted time of 7 days it will be re-homed.

Please ensure that your animals are safe in their own yard
