#### Installation of Shipping Containers

Development consent may be required for the installation of shipping containers.

\*\*Do you have a shipping container located on your land?\*\*

The installation of a shipping container is often seen as a cost effective option for storage. However, it is illegal to install a shipping container on land without development consent where consent is required. In addition, Council's Development Control Plan requires all shipping containers to be tied down to an adequate footing system designed by a Structural Engineer.

If you have a shipping container on your land and it does not have the appropriate approval it is requested that you either remove the container or lodge a development application with Council.

Contact Council's Development and Environmental Directorate on 6930 1800 to learn more and make sure you are not liable for enforcement action.



#### Wandering or Stray Dogs

As a dog owner, you have a responsibility to keep your dog contained inside your property which means you need to have fencing that your dog can't jump over, dig under, push over or get through. If you don't have fencing, your dog must either be kept inside an enclosed space or chained to a fixed point or dog run. If a dog is found "at large" and seized by Council, your dog may be taken to Council's animal holding facility and you could attract a \$330 penalty notice (fine) plus any pound fees.

Allawah Lodge is receiving a large number of enquiries about coming into Allawah Lodge for respite or permanent care. On many occasions we are unable to provide care because the person has not been APPROVED for care by the government through MY AGED CARE.

It's a timely reminder, if you are thinking you may want to access care now or in the future you MUST have an AGED CARE ASSESSESSMENT (ACAT).
