All dogs and cats in NSW must be microchipped by the age of 12 weeks and registered by the age of 6 months. Failure to do so will incur a fine of \$330.00 per dog. Registration will still be required to be paid as well as the infringement notice.



The fine for owners of dogs that are found wandering from their place of residence is also \$330.00

There are a number of companion animals that are roaming the streets and are not able to be identified and returned to their owners. Animals that are not able to be identified within the allotted time of 7 days will be re-homed.

Please ensure that your animals are safe in their own yard and not causing a nuisance to the wider community.
