Local Government Week 2020

Local Government week provides an opportunity for Council to highlight what we, as an organisation do. This year's Local Government Week theme is "Councils Do". Did you know?

Local Government in NSW;

- Employs more than 55,000 people
- Looks after more than \$136 billion of community assets.
- Has 450 Council-run libraries that attract more than 34.8 million visits each year.
- Is responsible for about 90% of the state's roads and bridges.
- Manage an estimated 3.5 million tonnes of waste each year.

Clean-up Campaign

Monday 7th September – 11th September 2020

This clean-up is open to residents of the Coolamon Shire. This is for residential Community waste only, no waste from industrial or commercial premises will be collected as part of this campaign.

The purpose of this clean-up is to assist | Clean - Up residents with the removal of larger

items to the Waste Landfill Depot. Please ensure that all items are placed at the front or rear of the premises in a convenient position that will not hinder normal access. Items will not be collected if they are not easily accessible and should be ready for collection on Monday 7th September, for pick up that week.

In order to conduct this clean-up as efficiently as possible, all items to be collected must be registered with Council by Friday 28th August **NO REGISTRATION - NO PICK-UP** 2020.

Council will collect large household items such as old furniture, water tanks, car bodies, fridges etc.

Companion Animals

Owing an animal means that you are responsible for the wellbeing and actions of your animal.

All dogs and cats in NSW must be microchipped by the age of 12 weeks and registered by the age of 6 months. Failure to do so will incur a fine of \$330.00 per animal. Registration will still be required to be paid as well as the infringement notice.

The fine for owners of dogs that are found wandering from their place residence is also \$330.00



There are a number of companion animals that are roaming the streets and are not able to be identified and returned to their owners. Animals that are not able to be identified within the allotted time of 7 days will be re-homed.

Please ensure that your animals are safe in their own yard and not causing a nuisance to the wider community.

Ardlethan Sewerage

Installation of sewer reticulation has been completed, Pump Station commissioned and Sewerage Treatment

Plant is ready for inflows. Landholders are now free to advise their plumbers that connection to the sewer main can now occur. Contractors will still remain in Ardlethan for a number weeks to backfill trenches, clear stock piled excess fill, clean roads and provide general clean-up. Cooperation and understanding of Ardlethan residents during construction of this significant project is appreciated.


